Standard Breeds

- <u>Bantams-</u> Miniature chickens, sold as a straight run assortment only (unsexed) and will be a mixture of breeds. They will lay small eggs that have a ratio of about ½ the size of a standard chicken egg.
- <u>Barred Plymouth Rock</u> One of the oldest breeds; known as reliable layers, laying the entire year producing about 220-280 large brown eggs per year.
- <u>Black Sex Link-</u> Hens will be solid black with a reddish cast in the face, neck, and chest. They consistently lay large brown eggs throughout the entire year.
- <u>Cinnamon Queen</u>- These are dual-purpose birds that are good meat producers and prolific layers of large brown eggs. They have a friendly demeanor making them good pets.
- Golden Comet- Also known as Golden Sex Link, these birds lay high quality brown eggs and average 1 egg per day = 330 per year. Comets are robust and have a calm demeanor.
- Red Cross- A crossbreed from a Rhode Island Red male and a Columbian female. They have a calm nature making them idea for commercial or backyards and they are layers of large brown eggs.
- Rhode Island Red- Known for laying earlier than other breeds. They will start producing extra-large light brown eggs between 4 and 5 months of age. Their large size makes them a dual-purpose breed and can provide both meat and egg production.
- <u>White Leghorn-</u> The all-around profit bird; bred for livability, performance, high production, superior shell strength, egg size and feed efficiency. These birds will produce extra-large white eggs with a laying average of 4-6 per week.
- <u>Americana-</u> These birds express a wide variation of colors and sizes. They are also known as Easter Egger's because of the variety of colored eggs they lay.
- <u>Buff Orpington-</u> Great for beginners, these birds are calm and have pet type behaviors while still being hardy. They are excellent at producing large brown eggs.
- **Golden Laced Wyandotte**-Known for their beauty rather than egg production, with a feather pattern combination of rich golden brown laced with a greenish-black tipped feather. Averaging 200 medium brown eggs per year.
- Light Brama-These birds have heavily feathered shanks and toes and are dependable producers of large brown eggs.
- <u>Silver Laced Wyandotte-</u> Known for their beauty and production they have silvery white feathers, laced with black and will lay large brown eggs.

Rare Breeds

- <u>Barnevelder-</u> A medium-sized bird that lays deep brown eggs. They are known for their calm temperament and feathers of a gorgeous burnt orange and black lacing throughout.
- <u>Blue Rock-Crossing Barred Plymouth Rocks and Blue Andalusians leaving us with a sex-linked, production breed. These monochromatic hens will be light gray fading into a charcoal head. They are producers of large, light to medium brown eggs.

- <u>Dark Brama-</u> These lay medium to large brown eggs. They are known for their calm temperament and feathered shanks and toes.
- <u>Noir Maran-</u>An exceptionally good layer of rich deep brown eggs ranging from copper to chocolate in color. Hens are a large hardy black bird.
- Olive Egger- A wildcard! They will grow out in every color and/or combination of muffs and beards. They lay moderately sized, green eggs ranging in color from sage to olive.
- Rhode Island Blue- This a hybrid crossing two of the best layers the Rhode Island Red and the Australorp. They are medium-sized production birds that will range in colors of blue, black and red. Excellent layer of large brown eggs.
- <u>Welsummer-</u>They are a curious and intelligent breed with a calm temperament. They will produce dark reddish-brown eggs that are medium to large size.

Extremely Rare Breeds/Egg Production

- <u>Black Copper Maran-</u> An active, feather legged breed that loves to forage. They lay quintessential dark eggs that range from caramel to chocolate.
- <u>Cream Lebar-</u> They will produce medium sized blue robin-egg-colored eggs. They are an auto-sexing breed, the females will be much lighter than the males. This will make it easy to tell them apart at hatch.
- <u>Lavendar Orpington</u>-They are violet or blue in color and produce medium to large brown eggs. They tend to be broody while keeping a pet-like demeanor.
- Splash Laced Red Wyandotte- The most sought-after Wyandotte, dense-deep brick-red feathers outlined by white lacing with a splash of blue. You do not have to sacrifice production with these ornamental birds as they are still dual-purpose and provide large brown eggs.
